## Rules for treating printed book

- 1. If it is possible use copy of the book, prioritize copy version and not the original.
- 2. While receiving the book check if the book is useful, otherwise you will not have the opportunity to prove your innocence when defect oft he book is found.
- 3. Do not turn up the book, even when it has soft cover.
- 4. Do not try to flip through the book, if it is not possible.
- 5. Do not flip the corner of the paper in the book, when you do not have bookmark.
- 6. Do not attempt to straighten a folded or damaged cardboard sleeve, consult a librarian if a defect is found.
- 7. Do not lean on the book with your elbow while reading.
- 8. Try not to drop the book.
- 9. Do not make own notes in the book with pencil or a pen.
- 10. Do not bring into the library materials that could damage the book (food, coffee, tea, glue, ink and etc).
- 11. Try not to eat and dring while reading, do not draw a pencil on an open book.
- 12. Give back the librarian the book, do not leave on the table or give to other person.

## The treating rules with electronic book

- 1. You have the opportunity to open and download the book for individual use after getting and entering the unique code in the website.
- 2. It is forbidden to spread the electronic version of the book
- 3. If you do not obey this rule, your status of the library reader might be stopped and you will not have access on the library resources anymore.
